To provide the very best care to the person with a life-limiting illness and support for their loved ones.

We understand there are many mixed feelings and emotions when we think about the end of someone's life and recognise the importance of people getting the right advice and support when this is needed. The website pages were launched in March 2024 to provide guidance, education and support for people across Gloucestershire to help navigate the range of care and services available for people, their families and carers.

Information is provided for a range of different topics including:

- Planning ahead enabling a person to think about what matters to them and plan for their future
- Provision of palliative and end of life care providing information to help towards the end of someone's life
